

BLANC or NOIR or INDIEN yarn.

[74(78,86,92,102) sts]

When work meas 33 cm after ribbing, shape armholes:

**1st size**, on each edge, cast off 3 sts once, 2 sts once, and 1 st 3 times.

**2nd size**, on each edge, cast off 3 sts once, 2 sts twice, and 1 st twice.

**3rd size**, on each edge, cast off 3 sts once, 2 sts 3 times, and 1 st 3 times.

**4th size**, on each edge, cast off 4 sts once, 2 sts 3 times, and 1 st 4 times.

**5th size**, on each edge, cast off 4 sts twice, 3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st twice.

[58(60,62,64,66) sts]

When work meas 52(53,54,55,56) cm after ribbing, shape shoulders:

**1st size**, on armhole edge, cast off 4 sts once, and 5 sts once.

**2nd size**, on armhole edge, cast off 5 sts twice.

**3rd size**, on armhole edge, cast off 5 sts once, and 6 sts once.

**4th size**, on armhole edge, cast off 5 sts twice, and 6 sts once.

**5th size**, on armhole edge, cast off 6 sts twice.

At the same time, shape neck by casting off 40(40,40,42,42) center sts.

## TO FIT

To fit 34/36(38/40,42/44,46/48,50/52)  
- see diagrams for actual measurements

## MATERIALS

### Version A

PHILDAR AVISO: 9(10,11,12,13) balls of BLANC, and 2(3,3,3,4) balls of DAUPHIN

### Version B

PHILDAR AVISO: 9(10,11,12,13) balls of NOIR, and 2(3,3,3,4) balls of ECRU

### Version C

PHILDAR AVISO: 9(10,11,12,13) balls of INDIEN, and 2(3,3,3,4) balls of MARINE

1 pair each of size 3.5 mm (UK 9 US 5), 4 mm (UK 8 US 6), and 5 mm (UK 6 US 8) knitting needles.

## STITCHES

### K2, p2 rib

**1st row (right side):** \* k2, p2 \*, repeat from \* to \*, ending with k2.

**2nd row (wrong side):** P2, \* k2, p2 \*, repeat from \* to \* to end of row.

These 2 rows form pattern.

### Reverse stocking stitch:

**1st row (right side):** P all sts

**2nd row (wrong side):** K all sts

These 2 rows form pattern.

### Rev stocking stitch stripes:

\* 4 rows using DAUPHIN or ECRU or MARINE, 8 rows using BLANC or NOIR or INDIEN \*

These 12 rows form pattern

## TENSION

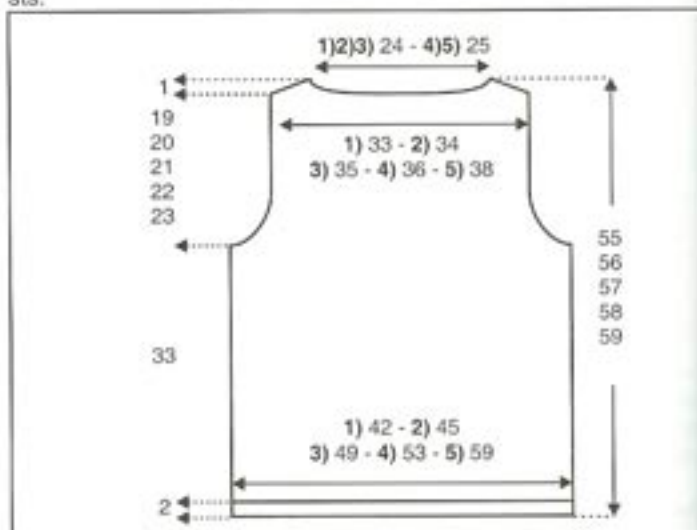
Be sure to check your tension before starting to knit if tension is too tight, change to larger needles; if it is too loose, change to smaller needles.

17 sts and 22 rows to 10 cm measured over rev stocking stitch and rev stocking stitch stripes using 5 mm needles.

## BACK

Using 3.5 mm needles and DAUPHIN or ECRU or MARINE yarn, cast on 74(78,86,90,102) sts and work in k2, p2 rib, beginning and ending 1st and foll all rows (right side) with k2; work for 2 cm.

Change to 5 mm needles and work 6 rows of st st using BLANC or NOIR or INDIEN yarn, and for 4th size only, increase 2 sts on first row. Change to rev st st stripes (see STITCHES) and work 84 rows (i.e. the 12 rows in the pattern, 7 times), and end in rev st st using



## FRONT

Using 3.5 mm needles and DAUPHIN or ECRU or MARINE yarn, cast on 74(78,86,90,102) sts and work in k2, p2 rib using BLANC or NOIR or INDIEN yarn, beginning and ending 1st and foll all rows (right side) with k2; work for 2 cm.

Change to 5 mm needles and work 6 rows of st st using BLANC or NOIR or INDIEN yarn, and for 4th size only, increase 2 sts on first row. Change to rev st st stripes (see STITCHES) and work 84 rows (i.e. the 12 rows in the pattern, 7 times), and end in rev st st using BLANC or NOIR or INDIEN yarn.

[74(78,86,92,102) sts]

When work meas 33 cm after ribbing, shape armholes:

**1st size**, on each edge, cast off 3 sts once, 2 sts once, and 1 st 3 times.

**2nd size**, on each edge, cast off 3 sts once, 2 sts twice, and 1 st twice.

**3rd size**, on each edge, cast off 3 sts once, 2 sts 3 times, and 1 st 3 times.

**4th size**, on each edge, cast off 4 sts once, 2 sts 3 times, and 1 st 4 times.

**5th size**, on each edge, cast off 4 sts twice, 3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st twice.

[58(60,62,64,66) sts]

When work meas 43(44,45,46,47) cm after ribbing, shape neck by casting off the 14(14,14,16,16) center sts then cont working one side at a time. On neck edge of foll alt rows, cast off 4 sts once, 2 sts 3 times, and 1 st twice, then on foll 4th row, cast off 1 st once.

When work meas 52(53,54,55,56) cm after ribbing, shape shoulders:

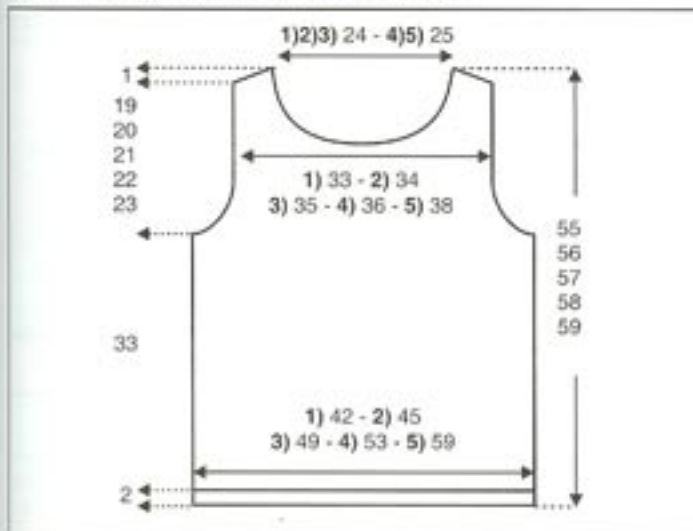
1st size, on armhole edge, cast off 4 sts once, and 5 sts once.

2nd size, on armhole edge, cast off 5 sts twice.

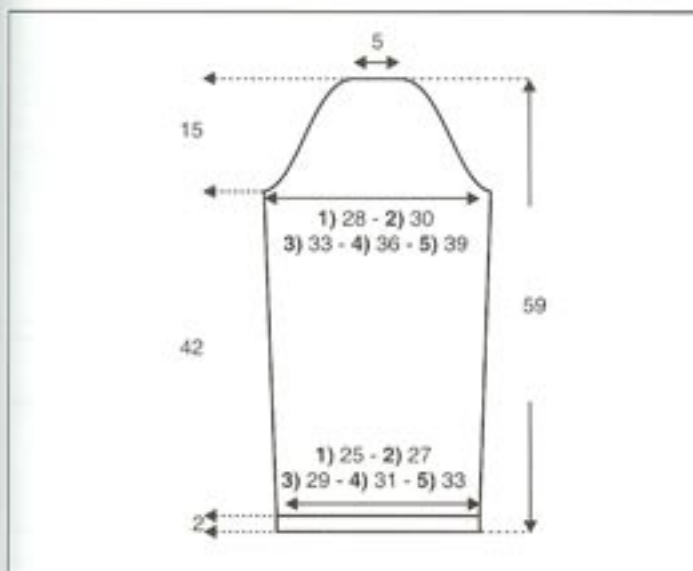
3rd size, on armhole edge, cast off 5 sts once, and 6 sts once.

4th size, on armhole edge, cast off 5 sts once, and 6 sts once.

5th size, on armhole edge, cast off 6 sts twice.



## ■ SLEEVES



Using 3.5 mm needles and DAUPHIN or ECRU or MARINE yarn, cast on 42(46,50,54,58) sts and work in k2, p2 rib using BLANC or NOIR or INDIEN yarn, beginning and ending 1st and foll alt rows (right side) with k2; work for 2 cm.

Change to 5 mm needles, and for 1st, 2nd and 3rd sizes only, inc 2 sts on 1st row.

You will have 44(48,52,54,58) stitches. Work in rev st st stripes, beginning with 14 rows of BLANC or NOIR or INDIEN yarn. Change

to rev st st stripes (see STITCHES) and work 84 rows (i.e. the 12 rows in the pattern, 7 times), and end in rev st st using BLANC or NOIR or INDIEN yarn.

Then:

1st size, on each edge of foll 24th rows, inc 1 st twice, and on foll 22nd row, cast off 1 st once.

2nd size, on each edge of foll 24th rows, inc 1 st twice, and on foll 22nd row, cast off 1 st once.

3rd size, on each edge of foll 24th rows, inc 1 st twice, and on foll 22nd row, cast off 1 st once.

4th size, on each edge of foll 20th row, cast off 1 st once, and on foll 18th rows, cast off 1 st 3 times.

5th size, on each edge of foll 16th rows, cast off 1 st 4 times, and on foll 14th row, cast off 1 st once.

[50(54,58,62,68) sts]

When work meas 42 cm after ribbing, shape slope of sleeve:

1st size, on each edge of foll alt rows, cast off 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice, on foll 4th rows, cast off 1 st 4 times, and on foll alt rows, cast off 1 st twice, 2 sts once and 3 sts once.

2nd size, on each edge of foll alt rows, cast off 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times, on foll 4th rows, cast off 1 st 3 times, and on foll alt rows, cast off 1 st twice, 2 sts twice and 3 sts once.

3rd size, on each edge of foll alt rows, cast off 4 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times, on foll 4th rows, cast off 1 st 3 times, and on foll alt rows, cast off 1 st twice, 2 sts twice and 4 sts once.

4th size, on each edge of foll alt rows, cast off 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice, on foll 4th rows, cast off 1 st 3 times, and on foll alt rows, cast off 1 st twice, 2 sts once and 3 sts twice.

5th size, on each edge of foll alt rows, cast off 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts once, and 1 st twice, on foll 4th rows, cast off 1 st 3 times, and on foll alt rows, cast off 1 st once, 2 sts twice, 3 sts once and 4 sts once.

When work meas 57 cm after ribbing, cast off rem 10 sts.

Knit other sleeve in same way.

## ■ NECK RIBBING

Using 4 mm needles and BLANC or NOIR or INDIEN yarn, cast on 94(94,94,98,98) sts and work in k2, p2 rib (see STITCHES), beginning and ending 1st and foll alt rows (right side) with k2; work for 4 cm, then k 1 row on right side and work several more rows of st st in a different color.

Iron these st st rows, when making up sweater you will simply unravel these rows to base color.

## ■ MAKE UP

Steam iron pieces to fit pattern measurements.

Sew various seams.

Sew shoulder, side and sleeve seams;  
Join sleeves.

Sew neck ribbing, matching sts, with back stitching on right side of work.
